CASE STUDY

Theatres 8 and 9 Refurbishment.

About the project.

This refurbishment scheme was the second phase of works relating to Theatres 8 and 9 with Brymor previously completing enabling works in the plant room, under a separate contract.

The interior makeup included PVC hygienic wall cladding, lead lined doors and solid ceilings finished in sterisheen paint. The design was to accommodate and encapsulate state of the art laser and radiotherapy equipment.

The theatres were supplied with new mechanical and electrical services comprising medical gasses linked to equipment pendants, CCTV, door locking systems and monitoring stations.

Our site teams experience, combined with our relationship with the chosen mechanical and electrical subcontractors, ensured that early verification of the design was achieved which, in turn, minimised any subsequent delays on-site.

Works were completed over a 12-week period and were programmed accordingly, in conjunction with our subcontractors, to ensure that the unit was shut down for the minimum amount of time.

This project also required very close liaison with the Clients project team and, in turn, with the staff in the adjacent theatres. The works sequencing, and project success could not have been carried out without a truly collaborative approach from everyone involved.
