City Cruise Terminal Phase 5a.

About the project.

We were pleased to work with ABP to transform the existing building into a new refreshed and modern cruise terminal.

The works involved:

- Construction of new pass office and crew x-ray areas.
- New carpets in terminal areas behind check-in and main area.
- Extend over-head steel cantilevered walkway, boarding, disembarkation from the ships and new emergency staircase.
- Installation of new wi-fi and baggage tracking system.
- Installation of new digital media TV and monitors in departures and arrivals locations.
- Installation of eight new Trelleborg bollards.
- Installation of new metal doors and screens.
- General refurbishment throughout.
